- 1. **OPENS:** Entries open 5.1.19.
- 2. CLOSES: Entries close 6.1.19.
- 3. **CONTACT**: Show Secretaries: Julie Cannova or Joanna Gray-Randle at grayhorsedressage@gmail.com.
- RULES: All classes being offered herein will be conducted and run in accordance with the current FEI/USDF/USEF Rules for Dressage, Eventing, Western (WD), PARA, Prix Caprilli, USDF Rider, and Musical Freestyle (MFS), unless otherwise specified.
- ENTRY FORMS: Only fully completed and <u>signed</u> entry forms, with payment in full, will be accepted. Entries must be received after the opening date and before the closing date.
- PAYMENT: <u>Make checks payable to: Gray Horse Dressage</u> and mail, along with completed entry form with required signatures, to: <u>P.O. BOX 1198, Sound Beach, NY 11789</u>. Mail by the closing date to avoid late fees. Or, pay by Credit Card (MC/Visa/Discover) with \$10 convenience fee.
- REFUNDS: No refund of entry fees and office/grounds fees after the closing date. Class fees may be refunded in the case of horse welfare with a note from a treating veterinarian, dated within five (5) days of the competition date.
- 8. **RETURNED CHECKS:** A \$35 Handling Fee will be assessed for returned checks.
- 9. **TEST LIMITATIONS:** Horse may be entered in a maximum of three (3) tests per show.
- 10. **CLASS COMBINING/SPLITTING:** Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any classes. Classes will be split by Junior and Adult only if entries warrant.
- TIMES: Tentative time schedule will be available 36 hours before the show, at <u>www.grayhorsedressage.com</u>. Additionally, if you provide an email address on the Entry Form, ride times will be emailed.
- 12. **LOCATION**: Sound Lane Dressage barn entrance is on Sound Avenue, between Phillips Lane and Church Lane. Use 5087 Sound Avenue in Aquebogue/Riverhead for a GPS setting.
- 13. **PARKING:** Ample parking, please be courteous to other drivers and trailers.
- 14. **STABLING:** Very limited day stabling available at a fee of \$55/day. First come, first served.
- 15. **ARENA:** Standard 20m x 60m arena will be used for all tests, rain or shine.
- 16. FOOTING: Sand in both competition and schooling arenas.
- 17. **SOUND CHECK FOR Musical Freestyle (MFS):** Sound check time will be listed on Day Sheet.
- 18. LUNGING: Lunging allowed in round pen at front of property only.
- FOOD: No food on premises, but a deli is conveniently located at farm entrance on Sound Avenue. GHD will provide light breakfast.
 PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: ALL RIDERS MUST wear
- 20. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: ALL RIDERS MOST wear ASTM/SEI Approved Headgear while mounted – there are ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS. Any rider found mounted without a properly fitted and secured helmet will be removed from the facility and all entry, office, grounds and stabling fees forfeited.

- 21. AWARDS:
 - a. Class placement ribbons to sixth place.
 - b. Champion and Reserve Champion for the day:
 - i. Lead Line, Intro to Fourth Level, USEA, PARA, and Western Dressage Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve Champion to the highest combined average and the second highest combined average of <u>two tests</u> <u>ridden at the same level</u>.
 - ii. FEI, USDF Rider, Prix Caprilli and MFS Champion and Reserve Champion will be given to the highest and second highest score of one test.
- 22. **RELEASE OF LIABILITY:** All competitors, participants, spectators, family members, trainers, teachers, coaches, and basically anyone who sets foot or drives upon the Sound Lane Dressage property and participates at any level in the Gray Horse Dressage Schooling Show, does so at their own risk. Gray Horse Dressage, Sound Lane Dressage, and/or the show committee, and all their heirs and assigns, disclaim any and all liability for any accident or occurrence, despite the cause.

2019 Gray Horse Dressage Year End Awards Program

~ Recognizing and Rewarding Excellence in Dressage ~

Rules & Requirements

- 1. <u>Awards Year</u>: Gray Horse Dressage (GHD) Awards Year is January 1st, 2019 to December 31st, 2019.
- Participation Fee: No Annual Membership Fee! To participate in the Gray Horse Dressage Year End Awards Program, each Competition Entry must include the \$10 GHD Y/E Awards Participation Fee, PER DIVISION, for the scores earned at that show to count towards GHD Year End Awards. (For example, if riding in our Dressage Schooling Show at Training Level only, add \$10 to your entry to have your scores count towards year-end awards. If you are riding at both Training and First Level, in the same dressage show, include \$20 for scores to count.
- 3. <u>Entry</u>: The horse and rider combination must be the same for all eligible scores.
- 4. <u>REQUIRED NUMBER OF TESTS</u>: <u>TWO Tests of EACH Level must be ridden, with one being from the highest test of the level, to be considered for Year End Awards for all Non-FEI. ONE Test is required for FEI Divisions.</u>
- 5. <u>Submission of Scores</u>: GHD will track scores and compile results <u>no submission forms to fill out</u>!
- 6. <u>Eligibility of Scores</u>: Scores <u>must</u> be earned from <u>GHD Competitions</u>.
- 7. <u>Awards</u>: Ribbons and Special Prizes will be awarded to Champion and Reserve Champion; and year-end award ribbons will be awarded for third place through sixth place.
- 8. <u>Divisions</u>: Year-End Awards will be presented in Open, Adult Amateur and Junior/Young Rider divisions.
- 9. <u>Categories</u>: Year-End Awards will be presented in the following categories:
 - a. Dressage:
 - i. USDF Introductory Level, USEF Training Level, USEF First Level and USEF Second Level
 - ii. USEF Third Level and Above Test of Choice
 - iii. FEI Test of Choice
 - iv. USDF Musical Freestyle (MFS) Test of Choice
 - v. FEI Musical Freestyle (MFS) Test of Choice
 - vi. GHD Lead Line
 - b. Western Dressage: WD Test of Choice
- 10. <u>Final Standings</u>: Placings will be determined by the average of the eligible scores.
- 11. <u>Score Requirements</u>: Average of scores will be determined by the following:
 - a. Dressage (Intro to Fourth Level), WD, Leadline (excludes MFS)
 - i. Two (2) Scores at the same level
 - ii. One (1) Score from the highest test of the level
 - b. Dressage FEI, (excludes MFS)
 - i. One (1) Score at the same level
 - c. Dressage Musical Freestyle, both FEI and USDF
 - i. One (1) Score at the same level
- 12. <u>Preliminary Awards Notification</u>: Preliminary results will be available for review by December 31st, 2019.
- 13. Final Awards: Final Awards will be mailed or presented by February 15th, 2020.
